PLANNING AND PREPARATION

- * Unlimited phone, email and text communication, as needed.
- * Recommend and Review vendor contacts and information.
- * Create the vendor list and arrival time information, set up, and teardown details for all vendors.
- * Provide detail timeline of wedding day from getting ready to vendor clean up.
- Provide spreadsheet templates for the following: guest list, RSVP's, seating plan, photography shot list, payment schedule, ceremony music, and reception music play list.
- * Serve as point of contact/liaison for all vendors beginning eight (8) weeks prior to wedding date.
- Wedding planning spreadsheet to assist in creating your itinerary and details.
- * Comprehensive planning meeting to discuss final details.
- Regularly check on client's progress and to do list.

ON THE DAY OF THE WEDDING COORDINATION

- * Act as liaison between wedding party, family and vendors.
- * Final site walk-through to determine set-up and logistical lay-out.
- Coordinate reception activities with bridal party, banquet manager, photographer, music and video.
- * Oversee all details on wedding day from set up to breakdown at ceremony and reception site.
- * Be certain the Bride & Groom have time to eat their meal and receive a piece of wedding cake.
- * Disperse final payments to vendors/gratuities, as needed.
- Make sure everything is packed up at the end of the event (cake tops, toasting glasses, guest book, cake server, etc. and given to caretaker of your choice).
